ENVD 199. Special Studies: [Topic]. 1-5 Credits.

ENVD 201. Environmental Design Careers. 2 Credits.

Developing skills in strategizing career options and mapping to degree plan. Overview of professional communication, resume and cover letter writing, interviewing and networking skills. Previously taught as LA 301.

ENVD 210. Foundations in Environmental Design. 2 Credits.

Foundations of Environmental Design introduces students to the breadth and different paths of the Environmental Design major. The course will explore Environmental Design as a multidisciplinary topic which focuses on visual and spatial design skills applied to the context of environmental sustainability. Concurrent registration in ENVD 289 required.

Requisites: Prereq: ENVD 201. Pre- or coreq: ENVD 289.

ENVD 289. Environmental Design Studio. 6 Credits.

Study of places, their use, and how they evolve. Fundamentals of environmental awareness, social factors, and small-scale site design; abstract design and elementary graphic techniques.

Requisites: Pre- or coreq: ENVD 210.

Repeatable 1 time for a maximum of 12 credits

ENVD 299. Special Studies: [Topic]. 1-5 Credits.

ENVD 301. Environmental Design Careers. 2 Credits.

ENVD 399. Special Studies: [Topic]. 1-5 Credits.

Experimental course - topic varies.

ENVD 401. Research: [Topic]. 1-21 Credits.

Disciplined inquiry of a topic with varying techniques and assignments suited to the nature and conditions of the problem being investigated. Often pursued in relation to a dissertation or thesis.

ENVD 404. Internship: [Topic]. 1-12 Credits.

Professional practice in an organization that integrates concepts studied at the university with career-related work experience.

ENVD 405. Special Problems: [Topic]. 1-12 Credits.

Specialized inquiry into a particular topic by a student and discussed with a faculty member.

ENVD 406. Practicum: [Topic]. 1-12 Credits.

A series of clinical experiences under academic supervision designed to integrate theory and principles with practice.

ENVD 407. Seminar: [Topic]. 1-5 Credits.

A small group of students studying a subject with a faculty member. Although practices vary, students may do original research and exchange results through informal lectures, reports, and discussions.

ENVD 408. Workshop: [Topic]. 1-21 Credits.

An intensive experience, limited in scope and time, in which a group of students focus on skills development rather than content mastery.

ENVD 451. Environmental Design Media I. 2 Credits.

Environmental Design Media is the first course in a yearlong foundational environmental media sequence. The course focuses on fundamental concepts of digital and environmental design. Students cannot receive credit for both ENVD 451 and LA 451. Sequence with ENVD 452, ENVD 453.

Requisites: Prereq: ENVD 201.

Equivalent to: LA 451

ENVD 452. Environmental Design Media II. 2 Credits.

Environmental Design Media II is the second course in a yearlong foundational environmental media sequence. The course focuses on creating diagrams for environmental design site analysis. Students cannot receive credit for both ENVD 452 and LA 452. Sequence with ENVD 451, ENVD 453.

Requisites: Prereq: ENVD 451.

Equivalent to: LA 452

ENVD 453. Environmental Design Media III. 2 Credits.

Environmental Design Media III is the third course in a yearlong foundational environmental media sequence. The course focuses on 3D modeling and creating graphic content for environmental design. Students cannot receive credit for both ENVD 453 and LA 453. Sequence with ENVD 451, ENVD 452.

Requisites: Prereq: ENVD 452.

Equivalent to: LA 453
