The Media Studies minor provides an overview of mass communication and studies its impact on society.

The minor requires 24 credits; eight are required and 16 are chosen from a list of approved electives. Students who want to minor in media studies should declare the minor online. You must have at least a 2.00 UO GPA to apply to the minor.

Jour: Media Studies (JMS) majors cannot also earn a minor in Media Studies. Other SOJC majors pursuing this minor may overlap one "JCOM" course between the major and minor.

Media Studies Minor Requirements

Courses used to fulfill the minor requirements must be taken for a letter grade and passed with a grade of C- or better. SOJC majors in Advertising, Journalism, and Public Relations may use JCOM 201 for both the major and the minor.
