Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
Date of Commitment	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
Between February 25 and March 13	Student is responsible for \$1,000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Between March 14 and April 13	Student is responsible for \$2,000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Between April 14 and May 13	Student is responsible for \$3,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Between May 13 - May 30	Student is responsible for \$4,5000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

Cancellation Date**Cancellation Penalty**

May 31 or later

Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
At time of commitment	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
115 days to 70 days prior to program start	Student is responsible for \$2,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
69 - 46 Days Prior to Program Start	Student is responsible for \$3,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
45 days prior to program start, or after the program has started	Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

70 Days prior to program start	Student is responsible for \$3,000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued
69 - 46 days prior to program start	Student is responsible for \$4,700 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
45 days or fewer before program start, or on or after program start	Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

IMPORTANT: The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.

Students who cancel their participation must notify GEO in writing. Email is acceptable (geoinfo@uoregon.edu). Verbal notification to GEO or notification given to a non-UO campus study abroad office is not sufficient.
