Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
Upon Commitment to Program	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
50 - 70 days before program start	Student is responsible for \$3,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Less than 50 days before program start	Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
Date of Commitment	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
Between February 25 and March 13	Student is responsible for \$1,000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Between March 14 and April 13	Student is responsible for \$2,000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
Between April 14 and May 13	Student is responsible for \$3,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Between May 13 - May 30	Student is responsible for \$4,5000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
May 31 or later	Student is responsible for \$4,5000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
Cancellation Agreement Deadline (At the time of commitment)	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
50 - 70 days before program start	Student is responsible for \$3,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Less than 50 days before program start	Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

IMPORTANT: The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is

essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.

Students who cancel their participation must notify GEO in writing. Email is acceptable (geoinfo@uoregon.edu). Verbal notification to GEO or notification given to a non-UO campus study abroad office is not sufficient.
