## **Cancellation Policy**

| <b>Cancellation Date</b>                   | <b>Cancellation Penalty</b>                                |
|--------------------------------------------|------------------------------------------------------------|
| Upon acceptance to the program             | Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable program deposit.    |
| 8 weeks before program start date          | Student is responsible for 50% of total GEO program fees.  |
| Program start date or after program begins | Student is responsible for 100% of total GEO program fees. |

*Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.*

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**IMPORTANT:** The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.

Students who cancel their participation must notify GEO in writing. Email is acceptable ([geoinfo@uoregon.edu](mailto:geoinfo@uoregon.edu)). Verbal notification to GEO or notification given to a non-UO campus study abroad office is not sufficient.
