Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
Date of Commitment	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. ** Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
4 weeks after program commitment**	Student is responsible for \$2,000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
10 weeks prior to program start date OR upon confirmation of internship placement**	Student is responsible for \$3,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
7 - 9 weeks before program start date	Student is responsible for \$4,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
7 weeks prior to program start date or on or after program start date	Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

Date of Commitment	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. ** Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
Between February 25 and March 13	Student is responsible for \$1,000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Between March 14 and April 13	Student is responsible for \$2,000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Between April 14 and May 13	Student is responsible for \$3,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Between May 13 - May 30	Student is responsible for \$4,5000 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
May 31 or later	Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

Date of Commitment	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. ** Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
120 - 40 days before program start	Student is responsible for \$2,000 of the program fees.
39 - 1 day(s) prior to program start.	Student is responsible for 75% of the program fees.
On or after program start.	Student is responsible for 100% of the program fees.

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

IMPORTANT: The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.

Students who cancel their participation must notify GEO in writing. Email is acceptable (geoinfo@uoregon.edu). Verbal notification to GEO or notification given to a non-UO campus study abroad office is not sufficient.
