110 - 70 days prior to program start	Student is responsible for \$2,000 of the program costs.
69 - 46 days prior to program start date	Student is responsible for \$3,500 of the program costs.

Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
Upon acceptance into the program	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
50 - 70 days before program start	Student is responsible for \$3,500 of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Less than 50 days before program start	Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued

IMPORTANT: The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.

Students who cancel their participation must notify GEO in writing. Email is acceptable (geoinfo@uoregon.edu). Verbal notification to GEO or notification given to a non-UO campus study abroad office is not sufficient.
