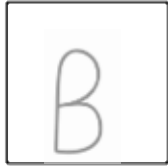

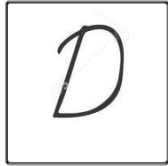

The story in WarGames better reflects risks today. In Dr. Strangelove, the problems are from human decisions and influence, while the problems in WarGames also involve computer issues. The imaginary threat in Dr. Strangelove is invented by a person, which can still happen today. But in WarGames, the threat is caused accidentally by hackers. While hackers today might not extend to launching a nuclear war, confusion caused by hacking can have real implications. The final decision about a nuclear launch in Dr. Strangelove is made by a person, while the almost-launch in WarGames is made by an AI system. This risk of AI miscalculation continues to exist today (in addition to bad human decisions).
