Do I Need Electives?

Electives are credits that go toward the overall 180 credits students need for graduation. Use the worksheet below to determine if you need elective credits. Only count credits once. Please be sure to consult your Ducks on Track and unofficial transcript to ensure accurate calculations. We encourage you to speak with an advisor to confirm and discuss your calculations.

Credits Completed On Ducks on Track, reference the top block's "Earned Credit" field. This number includes transfer credit that has already posted to your Transfer Evaluation Report on Duckweb. If you have transfer work that has not posted to your Transfer Evaluation Report, add those credits and be sure the official transcript has been sent to the Registrar's Office from your prior institution. Enter that total here.

Credits In Progress Write in the total number of credits for which you are enrolled, including any dual enrollment or credits at other institutions. Be sure to send the final official transcripts to the registrar's office to ensure they transfer and are added to your Transfer Evaluation Report. Remember you can generally only earn credits for courses once- do not double count credits.

Credits of Remaining Requirements Add the total number of credits you have remaining by counting any unfinished/future course work requirement credits reflected on your Ducks on Track

Total Sum of Credits Add the above boxes. Should the total meet or exceed 180 credits, you do not need electives. If you are under 180 credits, please see below for suggestions and/or make an appointment with an academic advisor to draft a plan.

I need more credits- what do I do?

Your options will depend on how many more credits you need, prior coursework, remaining requirements, and personal interests. However, below are some ideas to consider discussing with an advisor depending on the number of credits required: study abroad, add a minor, consider a Global Business Certificate, select an additional concentration, pursue independent academic interests, or take PE & Rec Courses.

Consult your Ducks on Track to confirm you have met all of your university requirements including residency, upper division credit minimums, etc.

GPA Requirements

For guaranteed admission to the full Business Administration and Accounting majors for Pre-Business students, a 3.0 cumulative GPA (including all transfer work) as well as a 3.0 Pre-Business Core GPA (consisting of the grades in BA 101z, EC 201, EC 202, BA 211z and BA 213z) is required
