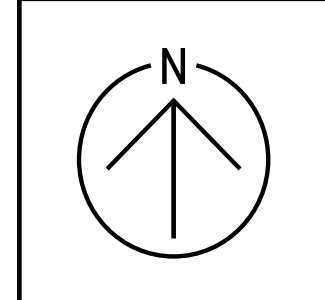




AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL

The third floor of the Lillis Business Complex includes an atrium bridge, two hallways, and three wings: Anstett Hall, Peterson Hall, and the Chiles Center.

The atrium bridge has suites 340 (the Development and External Relations office), 345 (the Lundquist Center for Entrepreneurship), 350 (the Dean's suite), and 355 (the Cameron Center for Finance and Securities Analysis), a stairway to other floors, and hallways to the East and West wings.

The East hallway has rooms 370-389 (including faculty offices), an accessible restroom, a stairway and elevator to other floors, and access to the East wing (also called Anstett Hall).

The East wing (also called Anstett Hall) has suite 391 (the Anstett Family Accounting Suite), rooms 393-398D (including faculty offices), and a stairway to other floors.

The West hallway has rooms 311-312 (including the building management office and a classroom), an accessible restroom, a stairway and elevator to other floors, and access to the West wings (also called Peterson Hall and the Chiles Center).

The West wing (also called Peterson Hall) has rooms 302-308A (including the Office of Advising and Student Experience, the Graduate Lounge, study rooms, and the Master of Accounting suite), and a stairway to other floors.

The far West wing (also called the Chiles Center) has rooms 320-327 (including the Business Technology Lab) and a stairway to other floors.
